Welcome to the San Antonio Botanical Garden. The staff and volunteers work hard to keep the gardens in the best condition possible and want you to enjoy your visit. To respect their efforts and the rights of others, please follow these guidelines.

1. Be sure that a teacher or adult always supervises students.
2. Keep students from running, throwing rocks, or being unruly.
3. Please stay on paths and walkways, especially in the Kumamoto En (Japanese) Garden, the Conservatory Rooms and in the display gardens.
4. Respect the plants and animals in the gardens. This is their home. Please do not chase the ducks and other wildlife.
5. For everyone's safety, please stay out of the fountains and ponds.
6. Students must be supervised while they are in the restrooms and gift shops.
7. Please leave the seeds, flowers, and leaves for others to enjoy. Permission to collect for special projects must be obtained in advance from Garden staff.
8. Picnicking is permitted in the Garden. Please bag all of your trash and place it near a trash receptacle.
